COLOR SEAL

Description:

Color Seal is a pigmented acrylic grout sealer designed to recolor, seal, and restore existing grout joints. It provides a consistent uniform color along with a highly sealed and durable finish.

Uses:

Use on sanded and unsanded grout joints including interior and exterior applications.

Coverage:

Coverage depends on the size of the tile and the width of the grout joint, per 16 oz. container. The following chart is approximate and coverage will vary for each application.

6 x 6	(1/8 grout joint)	400 sq/ft
12 x 12	(3/8 grout joint)	400 sq/ft
18 x 18	(3/8 grout joint)	600 sq/ft

Preparation:

Remove all dirt, mildew, wax, sealers, silicone, grease, cleaner residue, efflorescence, dust and foreign matter to provide a clean sound substrate. The surface should be allowed to dry for a minimum of 2 hours prior to application of the sealer. A neutral PH cleaner or floor stripper should be used. A final rinse with clean fresh water is required to remove all residue. To remove some sealers, an aggressive industrial stripper may be required.

Preapplication:

Always apply a test area to determine the suitability of this product. Apply a test area in an inconspicuous area to check for desired color, desired appearance and adhesion. It is the sole responsibility of the applicator to determine that the surface is free of dirt, mildew, cleaner residue, wax, sealers, silicone, grease and any foreign material that could inhibit adhesion of the sealer. New grout installations should be allowed to cure for 48 hours prior to colorsealing.

Application:

Read the entire label, this data sheet and the MSDS sheet prior to using color seal. Shake the container for 30 seconds prior to use. This shake will be sufficient for the duration of the job. It is best to work from a 16 oz container using a Yorker closure for an application tip. Do not overapply, less sealer is easier to cleanup. Apply Color Seal directly to the grout line followed by a scrubbing back and forth motion with an applicator brush. Only apply as much sealer that can be brushed within 10 minutes, otherwise sealer my not spread as easily. Limit the amount of Color Seal that is allowed to get on the tile—cleaning up the excess will be a lot easier. After the brushwork is complete, wipe up excess sealer with a smooth absorbent wiping cloth or synthetic chamois. Work grout lines in long streaches from wall to wall, then come across from wall to wall.

After Grout Color Seal has been allowed to dry for 1 hour, but no longer than 4 hours, remove excess dried sealer with plain water and a terry cloth. If excess sealer is stubborn to remove, use a nylon scrub pad. Always clean excess as you go, it is a lot easier to clean up when it is wet. The floor will be ready for light foot traffic in 4 hours.

Dry Time:

Dry to the touch is 1 to 2 hours depending on temperature, humidity and porosity. A partial cure is 8 to 24 hours. A full cure is 8 days. Do not attempt to use any cleaners until Color Seal is fully cured.

Clean-up:

Clean tools and wiping cloths with clean water. For final clean-up use warm soapy water.
